Convention Launches Fight for Contracts!

SEIU Local 26 represents almost 200 Janitors and 1000 airport Passenger service workers at MSP. Our union contracts covering these workers (along with 7000 other Janitors, security officers in the twin cities) are all expiring this winter. This is our chance to improve the standards in these contracts: Pay, health benefits, and our rights. On

Saturday, October 12th, hundreds of Local 26 members from across our union voted to ratify our industry wide proposals these negotiations. (see survey results and demands on other flyer)

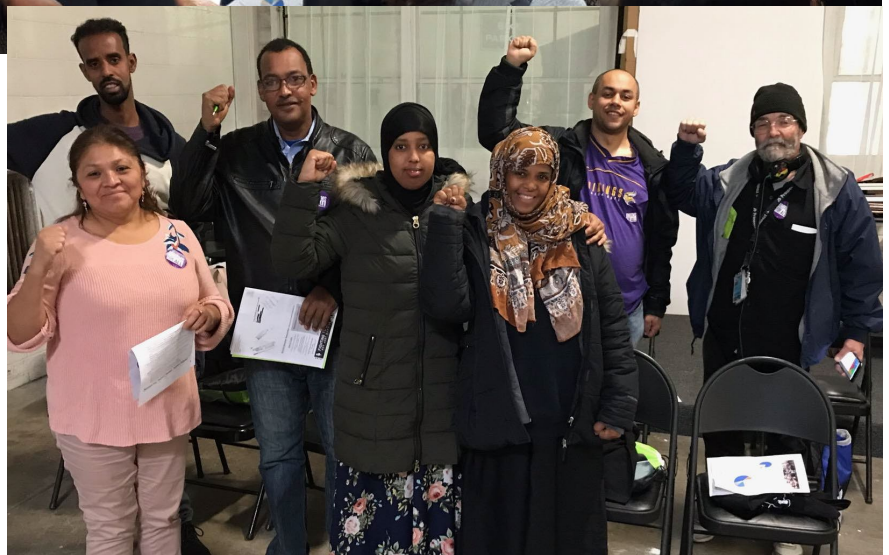


Workers elected as bargaining committee
