



SEIU Local 26 MSP Airport Bargaining Update #3

Clock is ticking: Airport Companies Can't Get It Together!

Our union requested to begin negotiations 3 months ago, but the companies only agreed to 2 dates. Our contract expires on Saturday Feb 1st, and we don't have final agreements on any of our major issues. Janitors and Security officers have had 7 or more negotiating sessions over the same time, all at a single table. At the airport, some of the companies still refuse to even be in the same room together.

G2 and Prospect propose to eliminate protections.

The companies proposed to:

- Eliminate the separation between job classifications, removing them from the contract. This could remove any protections from your supervisor assigning you to do other work.
- Eliminate emergency short-term loan
- Eliminate protections when contractor change: you no longer have your seniority, hours, or pay protected.

It's time for health insurance and vacation! Janitors and security at the airport have health insurance for around \$40 per month, and paid disability for 3 months if they are sick. They have vacation and bereavement leave: **WHY NOT PASSENGER SERVICE WORKERS?**

"I was in the bargaining yesterday and US aviation bargain with us separately, G2 and prospect they come to bargaining the same time, and they said to us that they are going to change the work classification to passengers service, that means if you are cart driver they can send you to push wheelchair, and if you are wheelchair assistance they can send you to do bags, this means they can send wherever they want.
