The Minnesota Homeownership Center can help. They have a network of homeownership advisors who speak several languages. They offer help with credit counseling, loan applications and the real estate purchase process. They offer information and application help for down payment assistance as well. They will help you to achieve homeownership!

Process

- 1. Go to HOCMN.org. Select "Buying a Home".
- 2. Select "Find an Advisor". There are 36 locations. Here are some samples.
 - a. NeighborWorks Home Partners English, Hmong, Spanish. Helping people buy, fix, and keep their homes.
 - b. African Development Center Amharic, English, Somali. Enabling the building of wealth through homeownership.
 - c. Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity English, Hmong, Somali, Spanish. Facilitating successful homebuying with coaching, education, and affordable mortgages.
- 3. Meet with Advisor to work on credit counseling and the mortgage application process. This could be in-person, via phone or via Zoom.
- 4. Select "Find a Workshop" for workshop locations. Workshops can qualify you for special loan products and down payment assistance.
